*There is an annual registration fee for the YMCA Before and After School program. \$20 for the first child; \$10 for each additional child. Registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Member rates will be given upon verification of membership. Membership must remain current in order to receive the member rate for child care. Refunds will not be given for unused days.

*For your convenience program rates are calculated and spread over the school calendar. See payment schedule for your site.

- Fees are based on schedule not attendance.
- Payments are due on or before the first of the month.
- Payments are accepted via Automatic Bank Draft or Credit Card Draft.
- Payments will not be accepted on site.
- All changes must be submitted in writing to the YMCA no later than the 26th of any given month.

7. Social Competence and Conflict Resolution

The YMCA of the Pikes Peak Region recognizes that exceptional, caring adults are essential to the healthy development of children. Our staff exceed state licensing requirements for experience and training. All staff are required to pass a state and national background check before they are hired and references are extensively checked. Additionally, all staff are First Aid/CPR certified making YMCA school-age programs the standard in safety and quality.

HOURS

The before school program opens at 6 or 6:30am based on school site and runs until the school day begins. The after school program runs from school dismissal until 6pm. A late fee will incur for late pickups.

SCHOOL'S OUT DAYS AND SNOW DAYS

Our School's Out Day programs are offered from 6:30am to 6pm. Weather permitting, we have programs available on Snow Days and Delayed Starts with a modified schedule. Please see the YMCA of the Pikes Peak Region's Snow Policy for more information.

GETTING REGISTERED

All registration paperwork must be received by the Association Child Care office prior to a child's first day in the program.
